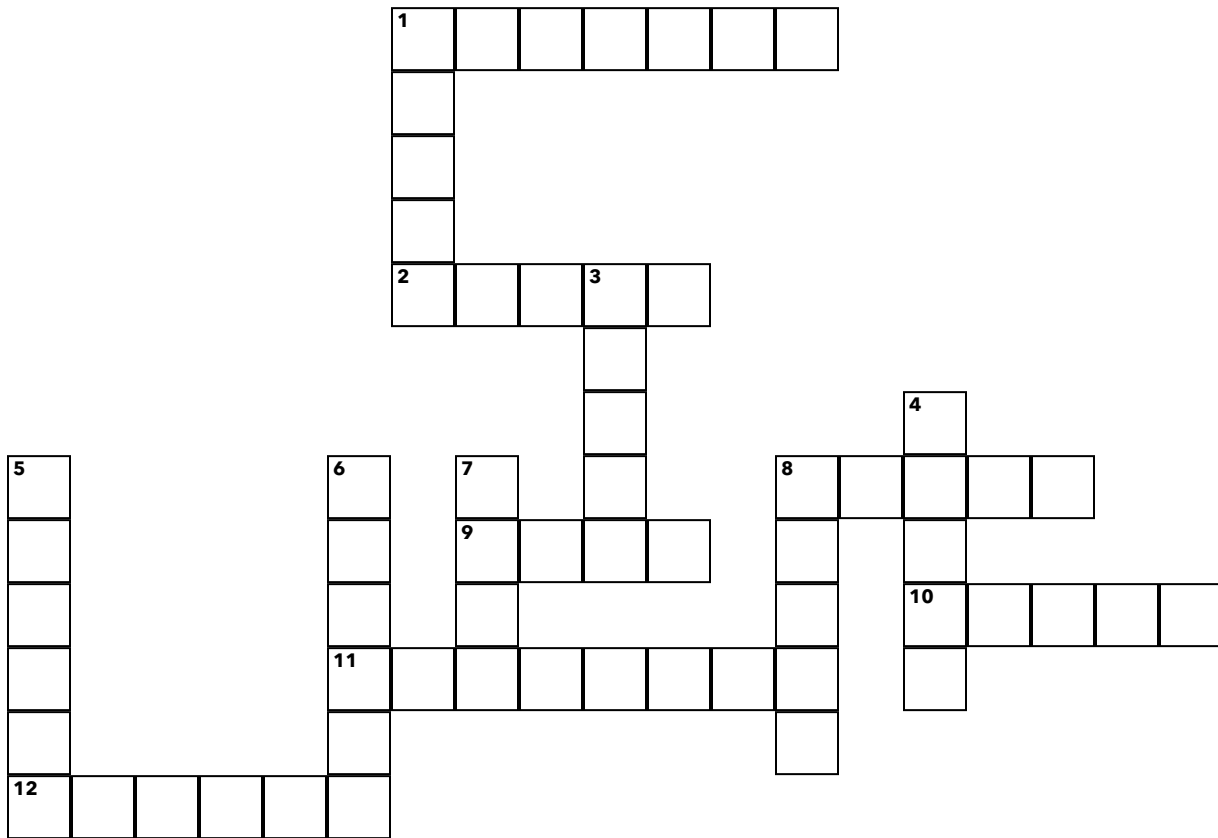


# Guru Amar Das Ji: The Third Guru

## ACROSS

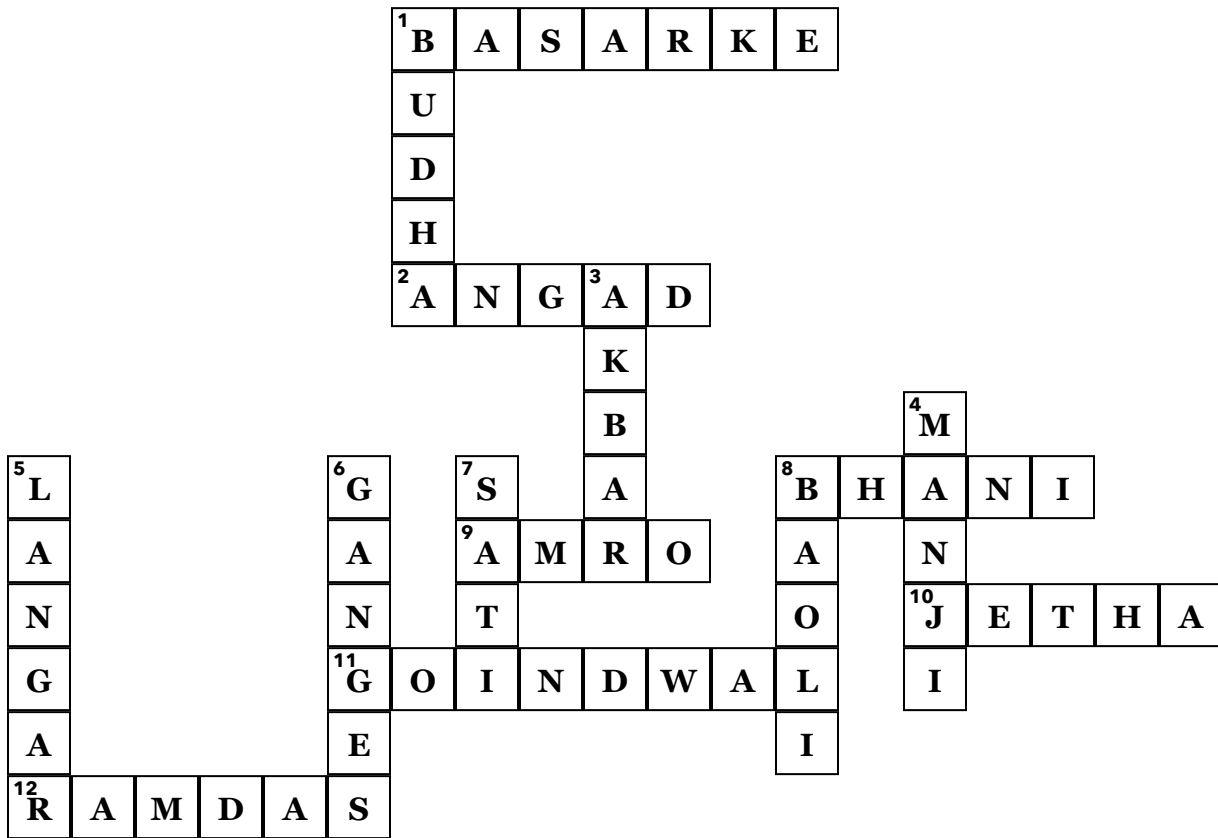
- 1 The village where Guru Amar Das was born and later hid himself in meditation.

- 10 The hard-working orphan who sold boiled grams, married Bibi Bhani, and became Guru Ram Das – Bhai \_\_\_\_.
- 11 The township on the River Beas that Guru Amar Das built as his centre.
- 12 The fourth Guru, formerly Bhai Jetha, chosen by Guru Amar Das – Guru \_\_\_\_ – two words.

- 1 The revered elder, Baba \_\_\_\_, who searched out Amar Das and brought him back to the Sangat.
- 3 The Mughal emperor who had to eat in the langar before he could meet Guru Amar Das.
- 4 One of the 22 preaching zones Guru Amar Das set up, each with a head missionary.
- 5 The free common kitchen everyone, even a king, had to eat in before seeing the Guru.
- 6 The holy river Amar Das visited twenty times before he found a true Guru.
- 7 The cruel custom of burning a widow on her husband's pyre, which Guru Amar Das fought to end.
