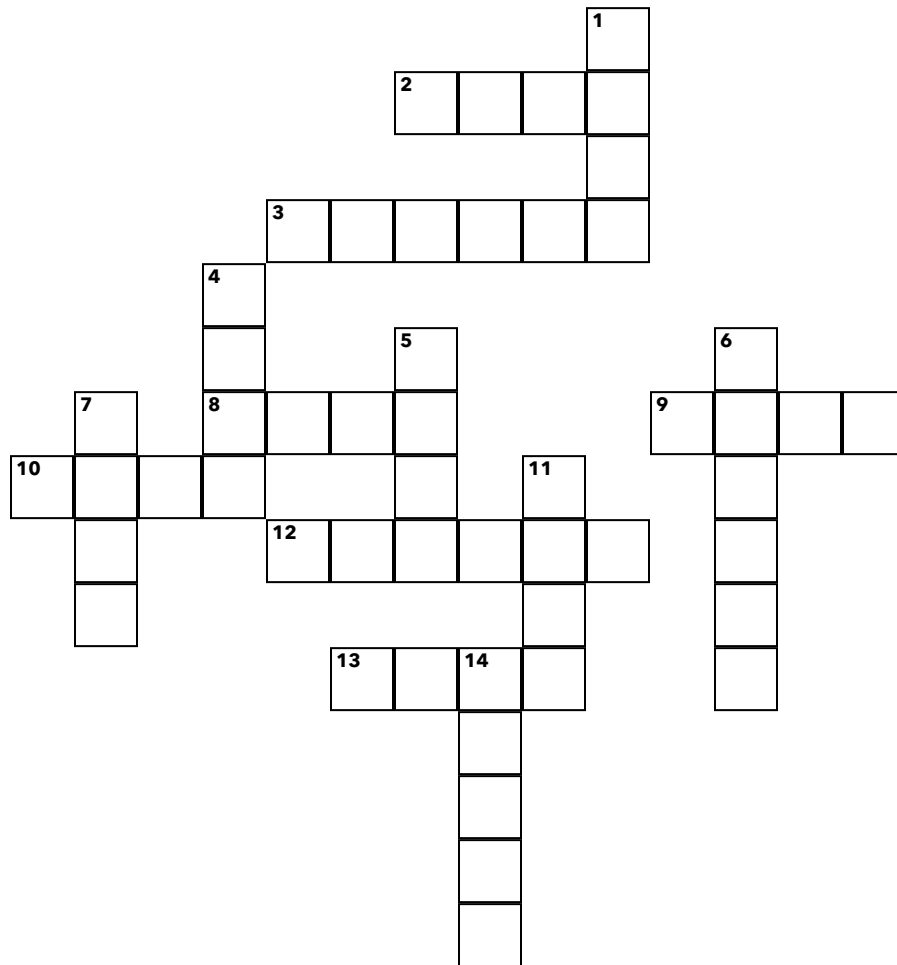


Punjabi Family Names: Rishtey in Punjabi

- 13 Your mother's brother; in Punjabi folklore he is the one who indulges children and offers a safe haven.

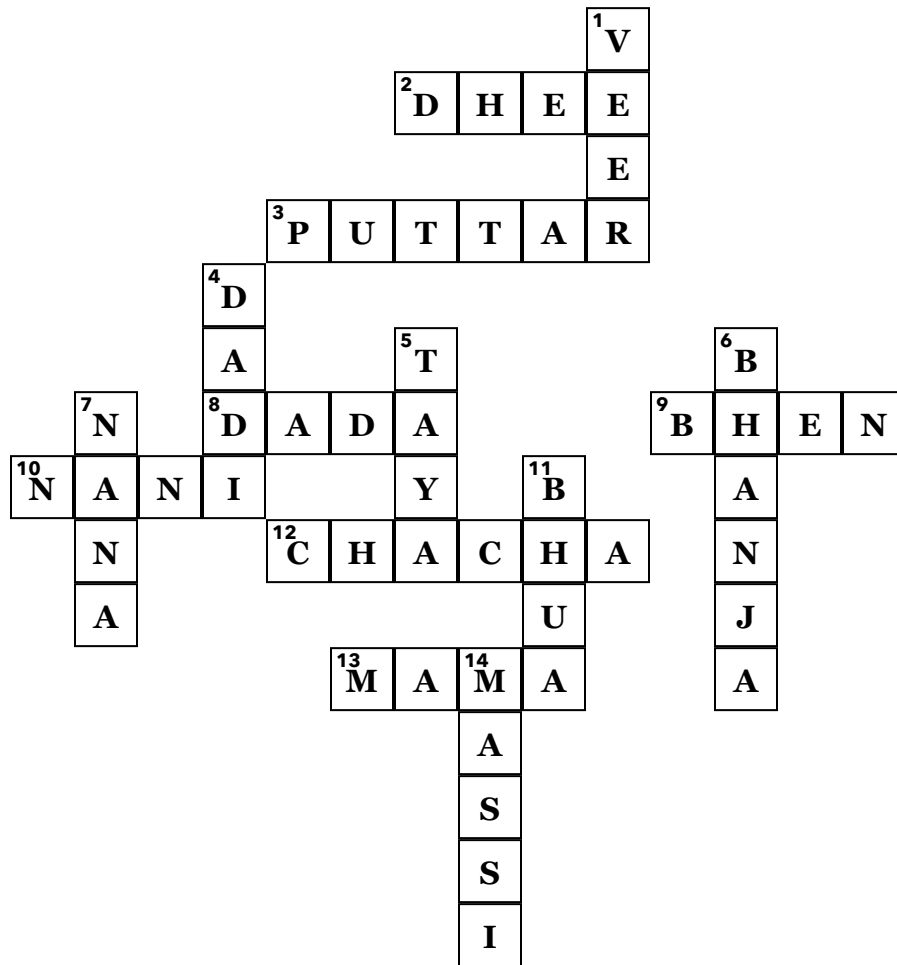
DOWN
